English Camp Internship Program (ECIP)

Program Highlights

- · Participate as a camp counselor in an eight week long English Language Camp for Korean college students (15 hours per week)
- Needs a few qualified counselor for the program (Approximately 8 people)
- Great opportunity to learn Korean language (10 hours a week) and its culture
- Direct interaction with peer Korean students at the camp
- Duty includes managing & counseling of camp participants, assisting class preparation, and instructing.

Period July 4 – August 26, 2011 (8 weeks)

Eligibility

- Students of CNU's partner university with good academic (cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above / 4.0 scale) and disciplinary standing
- · Native speakers of English or non-natives with sufficient English communication skills

+ Application Procedure

Students from Partner University

- Submit the completed application form and other supporting materials to the International Office at your university.
- 2 Obtain and submit the nomination from the International Office at your university.
- 3 Submit the completed application materials to the Office of International Affairs, CNU
- 4 Final admission decision will be made by the Office of International Affairs, CNU. <u>ECIP Applicants ONLY</u>: The phone interview will be followed for those who pass the initial admission review.

Students from Non-partner University (ISP Applicants ONLY)

+ Application Materials

For both ISP and ECIP Applicants:

- Transcript
- Medical Certificate: After an admission decision is reached, submit the proof of physical exam (including proof of no Tuberculosis) or use CNU's form that can be downloaded at http://cnuint.cnu.ac.kr/eng (Community menu – Notice No.15)

For ECIP Applicants ONLY:

- 1 Academic records showing cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above (based on 4.0 scale)
- 2 Non-native applicants only: Official English score (iBT TOEFL score of 80 or above, or its equivalent)

+ Payment Method

Payment method and refund/cancellation policy will be notified individually to those admitted for the program.

General Information

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Visa (for Tourism or Temporary Stay)

- No visa is required for students from country of visa free agreement with Korea.
- The temporary visit visa (C-3 status) is required for students from country without visa free agreement with Korea.

Certificate / Course Transfer

- Upon the successful completion of the programs, a Certificate of Achievement will be awarded and grade report (Pass/Fail) will be sent to your university.
- ISP: Offers total of 60 hours of Korean language and culture classes which are equivalent to 4 credit hours
- ECIP: Offers total of 80 hours of Korean language classes which are equivalent to 5 credit hours and 120 hours of internship training which are equivalent to 8 credit hours.
- The credit hours may be transferred in accordance with the regulations of your university.
- Consult your academic advisor to ensure the credit can be transferrable to your university.

Accommodation

- Room with double occupancy with single beds, closet, desks, and bathroom
- Newly-built modern on-campus housing with amenities such as computer room, laundry, reading room, snack shop, convenience store, fitness room, etc.
- Room and board includes room and 2 meals (breakfast & dinner) a day.





Arrival & Pick-up Service

 Airport pick-up service is available from the Incheon International Airport upon student's request: USD 80 (This pickup service fee is subject to change.)

Direction to CNU

- After clearing the immigration and customs, take airport shuttle bus to Daejeon at Bus Stop 9D located outside of the terminal at the arrival level.
- Ask bus operator to drop off at 'Jungbu-Chungsa' (Korea Government Complex) bus stop. (approximately 3 hour long ride)
- Take taxi and ask taxi operator to take you to 'Chung-nam-dae Gi-sook-sa' (CNU Dormitory, approximately 15-20 minute long ride)

Supporter System

- CNU student volunteers with English proficiency will be assigned to help ISP participants to acclimate the easy transition to Korea.
- Volunteers also participate in the Korean Culture classes to assist ISP participants to make your experiential learning process easier.
