

The Hebrew University of Jerusalem Summer Science Internship Program


Date: June-July 2018: 4 weeks, flexible dates (can be extended in consultation with

supervisor).
Credits: 4

Tuition: *Tuition waiver for exchange students*

Housing: US\$850 (for 4 weeks)

This summer internship program offers senior undergraduate and graduate students the opportunity to gain cutting-edge research experience in a wide variety of scientific fields while earning academic credit. Participants will work in a state-of-the-art laboratory, under the guidance of leading Hebrew University scientists participating in the program. Students intern for 40 hours per week.

Extra-Curricular Activities

The Office of Student Life (OSL) is responsible for organizing diverse extracurricular programs specially designed to introduce students to Israel. Housing

Dormitories are available on the Mount Scopus Campus.

Health Services

All exchange students at the Hebrew University are required to purchase health insurance coverage for the duration of their studies.

Admission Requirements

Undergraduate level program:

- 1. Students who have completed at least 28 semester credits from an accredited college or university with a 3.5 (B+) cumulative GPA or its equivalent are eligible to apply.
- 2. English: High Level of English (B2)

Graduate level program:

- 1. Qualified students with a bachelor's degree from accredited institutions of higher education are eligible for admission to the program. Students should have at least a 3.5 (B+) grade-point average.
- 2. English: High Level of English (B2)

Special admission requirements can be found in "List of Internships".

Eligibility

- ✓ Your home institution must be a HUJI partner through a formal reciprocal exchange agreement visit our website for list of partners
- ✓ You need to meet the above acceptance criteria.
- ✓ You need to receive invitation from a HUJI host for your internship

Note

- ✓ If selected, you remain enrolled with your home institution and continue to pay your home institution fees. You will be exempt from HUJI tuition fees.
- ✓ The credit points may be credited towards your degree by your home institution, on approval of your home institution.

Application Steps

- 1. Review the list of internship opportunities and establish contact with relevant contact persons (please mention "HUJI Summer Science Internship Program).
- 2. Obtain approval for internship from HUJI contact person.
- 3. Online application to HUJI May 15, 2018.
- 4. Notification of acceptance.

Application Materials to be submitted

- ✓ CV
- ✓ Letter of motivation (one page)
- ✓ Undergraduate level: Transcript of grades
- ✓ Graduate level: Copy of your bachelor of science or master of science degree
- ✓ Proof of English level (B2 or higher)
- ✓ One letters of recommendation from faculty members or academic advisors
- ✓ Letter of endorsement from Home Institution
