Program Dates: June 22, 2019 - August 18, 2019

A. Summer Session Program Timeline

December 3, 2018 (Mon) Stanford Summer Session Online Application opens

March 1, 2019 (Fri) Student selection list emailed to IHP Coordinator

March 13, 2019 (Wed) Application submission deadline in order receive Stanford ID number by the time Axxess opens for course enrollment on April 14

Applications will continue to be accepted until April 8, but students are not able to enroll in courses until all documents have been received and a Stanford ID number has been generated.

April 14 (Sun) Axxess opens for course enrollment.

Early April Submit Housing application

June 15 (Sat) Summer Quarter Cardinal Care Waiver Deadline; see the [Cardinal Care web site](#).

June 22 (Sat) IHP students arrive and check in during Welcome Weekend

June 23 (Sun) IHP Welcome Event

June 24 (Mon) First day of quarter; instruction begins.

June 24 (Mon, 5:00 p.m.) [Preliminary Study List deadline](#).

July 4 (Thu) Independence Day (holiday, no classes).

July 8 (Mon, 5:00 p.m.) [Final Study List deadline](#). Final day to add or drop a class; last day to adjust units on a variable-unit course. Last day for tuition reassessment for dropped courses or units. Students may withdraw from a course until the Course Withdrawal deadline and a 'W' notation will appear on the transcript.

August 2 (Fri, 5:00 p.m.) Course withdrawal deadline.

August 15 (Thu) Last day of classes.

August 15 (Thu) Last opportunity to arrange Incomplete in a course, at last class.

August 16-17 (Fri-Sat) End-Quarter examinations.

August 18 (Sun, 8:00 a.m.) Students leave their residence and return home.
