### Entry requirements

You are eligible if you:

- Have a current Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or above or equivalent grades
- Have met our minimum English language requirements if English is not your first language

## English language requirements

Courses are taught and assessed entirely in English and you must have strong English language skills. You must meet one of the following English language requirements:

- Be a native English speaker
- Have experience of studying in English at university\*
- Have achieved one of the following test scores:

Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English	Grade C or above
Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English	Grade C or above
CEFR	minimum score of B2
CET-4 (China)	minimum score of 550
CET-6 (China)	minimum score of 520
European Baccalaureate	60% or above
GCSE/IGCSE English Language	Grade C or above
IGCSE English as a Second Language	Grade B or above
IELTS	6.5 (with no less than 6.0 in each component)
HKDSE English (Hong Kong)	Level 5 overall (no less than Level 4 in any sub-section)
International Baccalaureate English	Standard Level Grade 5 or Higher Level Grade 4 or above
Pearson Test of English (Academic)	58 with a minimum of 51 in all communicative skills
TOEFL	90

*\*If you have studied in an English speaking institution or have courses at your university taught in English (excluding English language courses) you may meet our requirements without having to supply one of the above certificates. Evidence of this will either need to be included on a transcript or letter from your university.*
