Selection Process :

Applications will be evaluated based on the submitted documents and online interview. Selection results will be sent by April 30, 2020. Further information, payment method included, will be provided to those who have been successfully accepted.

Formally established in 1949, Kobe University is proud of its tradition as an education and research institution located in the cosmopolitan city of Kobe.

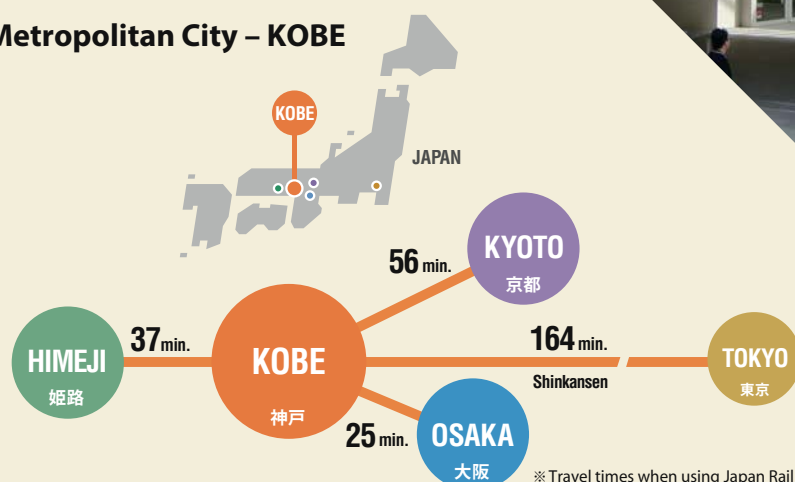

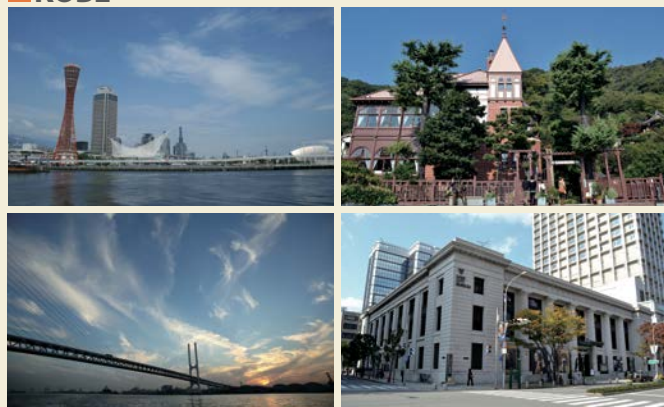
Location
