A tailor-made intensive French Summer Programme open to international exchange students and degree-seeking students attending Sciences Po from September 2012 onwards.

OVERVIEW

Sciences Po's Paris French Summer Programme is an intensive programme aimed at international exchange students and degree-seeking students attending Sciences Po from September 2012 onwards, who want to improve their French and their ability to talk about Social Sciences in French prior to the begining of their studies at Sciences Po.

The 2012 programme combines intensive French language classes and innovative theatre workshops with classes on French and European cultural history and political institutions.

The Summer Programme is also the opportunity to discover the vibrant culture of Paris, renowned for its museums, monuments and concert halls as well as other social, cultural and sporting activities.

PARIS CAMPUS

The French Summer Programme takes place at our campus located in the heart of Paris, at Saint-Germain-des-Près, close to the Louvre and the Quartier Latin, in the centre of one of the great cities of the world.

The Paris Campus dates back to the school's foundation. It draws on the city's incomparable cultural resources.

THE PROGRAMME

The programme provides students with the chance to improve their French language skills and to introduces them to subjects and methodology used at Sciences Po.

Courses and lectures are taught by Sciences Po teachers. In addition to regular classes, students will have two individual tutorials per week.

Nearly 66 hours of French as a foreign language taught by experienced teachers and theatre workshops enable students to put their French into practice.

The Language classes are supplemented by lectures highlighting the specificities and main issues of contemporary European and French history and society.

Social and cultural activities related to the teaching enable students to discover the area.

THE ACADEMIC TEAM

Courses and lectures are taught by a group of specialized and experienced professors affiliated with the best French institutions, including Sciences Po, Polytechnique, ESIT and who have also taught at overseas universities, such as Harvard, Columbia, and Princeton. "The programme is tailor-made for incoming Sciences Po students. It prepares them for the specifically French and Sciences Po teaching environments, and will significantly enhance their experience at Sciences Po"

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Open from March 5 to April 15, 2012

Forthcoming exchange students: register on line when applying for the exchange programme at Sciences Po.

Forthcoming degree-seeking students: return the application form to summer.school@sciences-po.fr, before April 15, 2012.

Admission into the programme will be confirmed by May 15 at the latest.

PAYMENT

The payment of programme and housing fees must be made by bank transfer to the Fondation Nationale des Sciences Politiques (FNSP). Please indicate the reference FSP as well as student's full name.

Admissions to the programme will not be accepted until full payment is received. Students are therefore advised to pay programme fees at the earliest opportunity in order to secure their place.

Full payment is due by May 30 at the latest.

PROGRAMME CANCELLATION POLICY

Students who request to withdraw up to three weeks prior to the beginning of the programme will be refunded 60% of programme fees paid.

Students who request to withdraw up to two weeks before the beginning of the programme will be refunded 40% of programme fees paid.

No refunds will be given to students who withdraw from the programme within less than two weeks before arrival or who leave before the end of the programme.

All refunds will be processed after the end of the Summer Programme.

All refunds will be made in Euros. Sciences Po can not refund any shortfalls due to exchange rate fluctuations or offer compensation for any bank or other charges incurred.

HOUSING CANCELLATION POLICY

Students who have requested a room at CIUP and request to withdraw up to one month before July 1st will be refunded 60% of the housing fees. No refunds will be given in the event of withdrawal one month prior July 1st.

INSURANCE

No refunds will be given in the event of withdrawal from the programme due to illness. All participants are advised to make sure they have adequate insurance cover while attending the programme. Contact
