1. Purpose and Objectives:

The Division of Public Partnerships (PPD) works to strengthen UNICEF's position as a partner of choice for children's rights among governments and public actors around the world. The PPPs team, based in New York and Brussels, works to facilitate this goal by catalyzing, enabling and scaling PPP partnerships in close collaboration with UNICEF's Private Partnerships Division

The team has two main functions:

1. To develop and enable UNICEF's global PPP strategy in partnership with UNICEF divisions and offices around the world .
2. To serve as relationship manager for UNICEF with leading finance agencies including Global Fund, GAVI, Global Partnership for Education

The PPPs team would welcome highly motivated and qualified candidates to join us from leading Chinese universities from January 2024, or July 2024.

2. Main responsibilities and tasks

Under the guidance of the Senior Advisor, PPPs, and in close collaboration with other Team members, the fellows will work to maximize PPP partnerships for UNICEF. Specific tasks include:

- Develop and update guidance notes and knowledge management materials
- Support development of PPP strategy and PPP proposals
- Financial analysis of income trends from PPPs.
- Assist in the preparation of briefing notes, reports, and other documentation required by UNICEF leadership for meetings with partners.
- Support creating and execution of convening events with public and private partners to catalyze new PPPs.
- Perform ad hoc research on engagement strategies and assist in maintaining up-to-date donor profiles
- Compile data, information, and news on PPP income and partnership trends within UNICEF and comparable agencies.
- Support other functions of the PPP Team as needed.

- Climate change is a particular focus for PPP projects at UNICEF, and one selected candidate will be asked to focus in this area, under joint supervision with the climate lead within the UNICEF Public Partnerships Division.

3. Recruitment Qualifications

Education	Must be enrolled, within the past year, in a graduate degree program with a preferred major in international relations, public policy, international development, law, environmental science, public health, education, or related field.

Language Requirements	Fluency in English is required.

4. Remuneration

The successful candidates must be supported with a monthly stipend for the duration of this internship under agreed arrangements with their universities or agencies such as the China Scholarship Council. There is no expectancy of employment at the end of the internship. UNICEF is not responsible for obtaining any necessary visas, but will provide visa support letters needed for visa application.

5. Insurance

UNICEF will not be responsible for costs arising from accidents and/or illness incurred during the volunteer's service. Therefore, the selected candidate must provide proof of enrolment in a health/accident plan prior to starting the internship.

The University will make an initial selection of applicants to be submitted to UNICEF no later than Oct 15, 2023.
